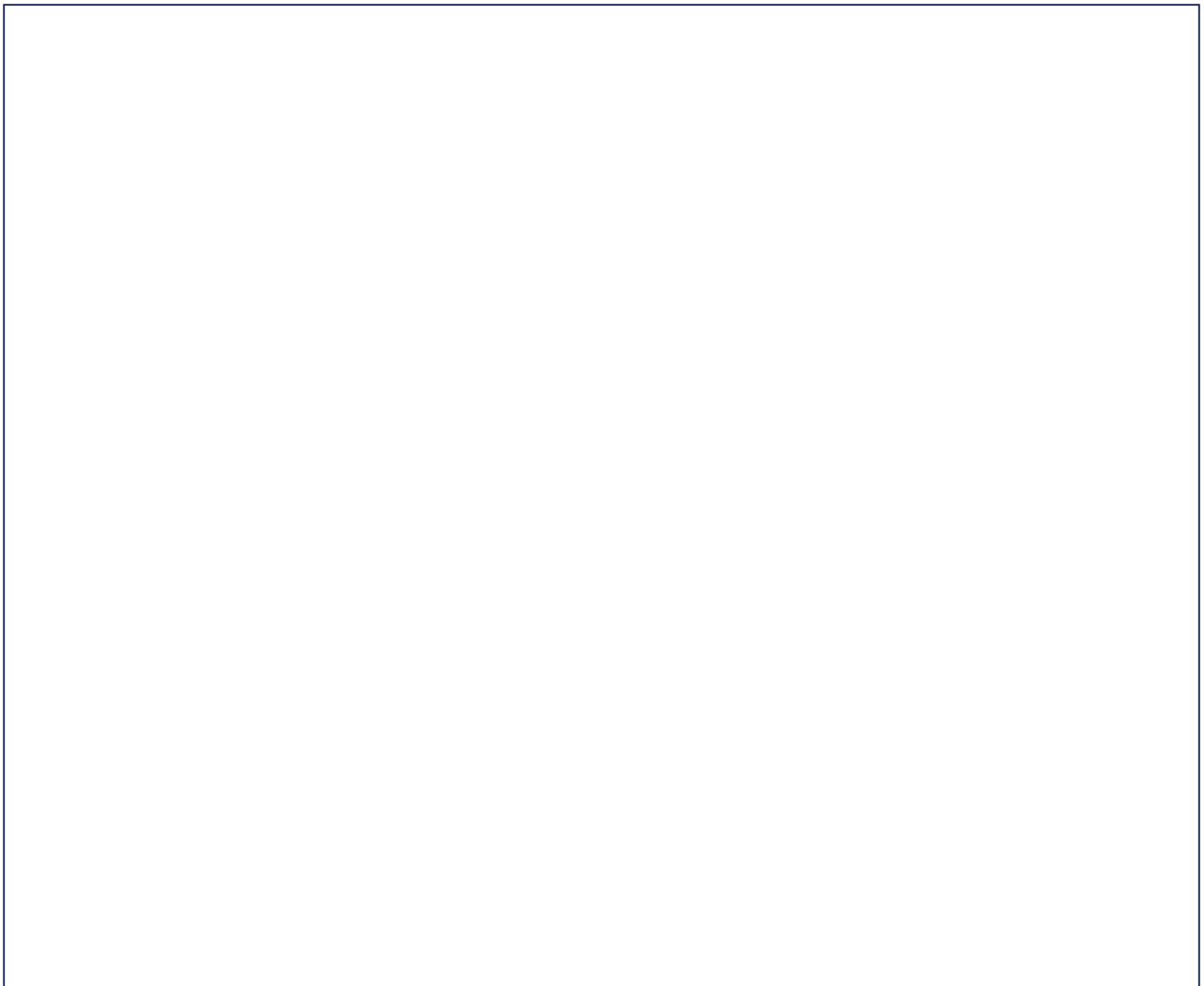


Finn's Amazing World Map

Learning objective: To identify and illustrate different natural environments (biomes) around the world.

Finn the Dolphin has travelled all over the globe! He wants to show you the different places he has visited. Use the space below to draw a map of the world and show Finn the different environments where animals and plants live.

Draw: Draw a large circle in the centre of the page to represent the Earth. Divide the circle into five sections. In the first section, draw golden sand and a cactus for the Desert. In the second, draw thick green leaves for the Rainforest. In the third, draw blue waves for the Ocean. In the fourth, draw white ice and snow for the Arctic. In the fifth, draw brown trunks and green leaves for the Forest. Add Finn the Dolphin swimming in the Ocean section.



Label words: Desert · Rainforest · Ocean · Arctic · Forest

Steps:

1. Draw a tall tree in the rainforest area of your map.
2. Draw a sun in the desert area. Why is it hot there?
3. Draw a snowflake in the cold Arctic area.
4. Label your drawing using the words from the word bank.
5. Which biome would you like to visit? Tell a friend why.
