2. Weather Watch: Is it usually hot, cold, or rainy in this place?

3. Nature Spotting: What kind of plants or trees grow in this place?

4. Animal Friends: Which animals might you see living here?

5. My Favourite Thing: What is the most exciting thing about this biome?
