- The weather tells us what is happening outside today, but the climate tells us what the weather is usually like in a place over a very long time.
- In the Arctic, the climate is very cold and snowy, which is why polar bears have thick fur to keep them warm.
- A tropical climate is often warm and rainy, helping tall green trees and colourful flowers grow big and strong.
- Deserts have a very dry climate where it does not rain very often, meaning the ground is often sandy and dusty.
- We use a thermometer to measure the temperature and see if it is a hot day or a cold day outside.
- Our world has four seasons: Spring, Summer, Autumn, and Winter, which help change how our environment looks throughout the year.

Did you know? Did you know? Some places near the equator are hot all year round, while the North and South Poles stay icy and cold, even when it is sunny!
