

Finn's Global Map Adventure

Learning objective: To identify and locate the world's seven continents and five oceans on a world map.

Finn the dolphin has been travelling the globe! Use your knowledge of geography to draw and label the world map below. Follow the drawing steps carefully to ensure all continents and oceans are in the correct place.

Draw: Draw a large, clear world map across the centre of the page. Use a pencil to sketch the shapes of the seven continents. Ensure the sizes are roughly proportional (e.g., Asia should be the largest). Use a blue coloured pencil to shade the vast areas of water between the landmasses to represent the five oceans. Add small decorative waves in the oceans and a compass rose in the corner showing North, South, East, and West.



Label words: North America · South America · Europe · Africa · Asia · Oceania · Antarctica · Pacific Ocean · Atlantic Ocean · Indian Ocean · Southern Ocean · Arctic Ocean

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw the outline of the seven continents. Label each one clearly using the word bank.
2. Step 2: Shade the five oceans in blue. Label each ocean in the correct location.
3. Which continent is located entirely in the Southern Hemisphere and is covered in ice?
4. Finn is swimming between Africa and the Americas. Which ocean is he in?
5. Explain why the Arctic Ocean is unique compared to the other four oceans.
