

# Exploring Our Planet with Finn the Dolphin

*Learning objective: To identify and name the world's seven continents and five oceans, and understand their geographical locations.*

Use your geographical knowledge to answer the questions below. Think carefully about where each continent and ocean is located on a world map.

Finn the dolphin is swimming on a grand adventure across the globe! He is currently mapping the world to help his friends understand where all the land and water is located. Remember, there are seven continents and five major oceans to explore.

*Word bank: Africa · Antarctica · Asia · Atlantic · Arctic · Australasia · Europe · Indian · North America · Pacific · South America · Southern*

**1. Finn is swimming in the largest ocean on Earth, located between Asia and the Americas. Which ocean is he in? (1 mark)**

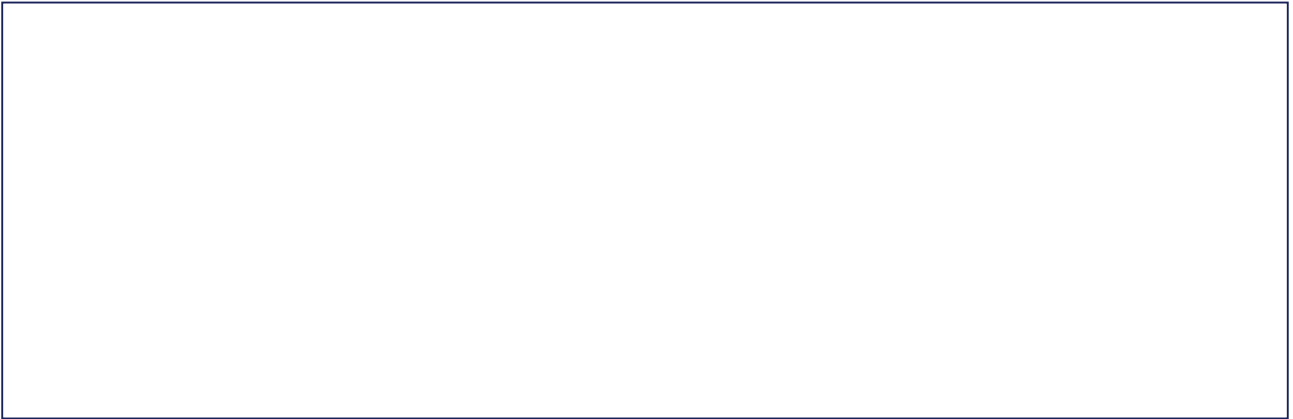
**2. Name the two continents that are completely surrounded by water and are located entirely in the Southern Hemisphere. (2 marks)**

**3. If you travelled from Europe to North America, which ocean would you have to cross? (1 mark)**

**4. List the seven continents in order of size, starting with the largest. (3 marks)**

**5. Why do you think it is important for explorers like Finn to have an accurate map of the world's oceans and continents? (2 marks)**

**Draw:** Draw a simple map of the world. Clearly label the seven continents and the five oceans. You may use different colours to show the difference between land and water.



*Extension challenge: Research one continent you have never visited. Write three interesting facts about its climate and the animals that live there, just like Nova the owl would do!*
