4. What kind of clothes would you need to wear if you visited the North Pole? (2 marks)

5. Finn travels through the water. How is the ocean different in the Polar Regions compared to the beach near your home? (2 marks)

Extension challenge: Imagine you are an explorer packing a bag for a trip to the snow. List three items you would bring and write down how much you think they might cost in pounds (£) if you bought them at a shop.
