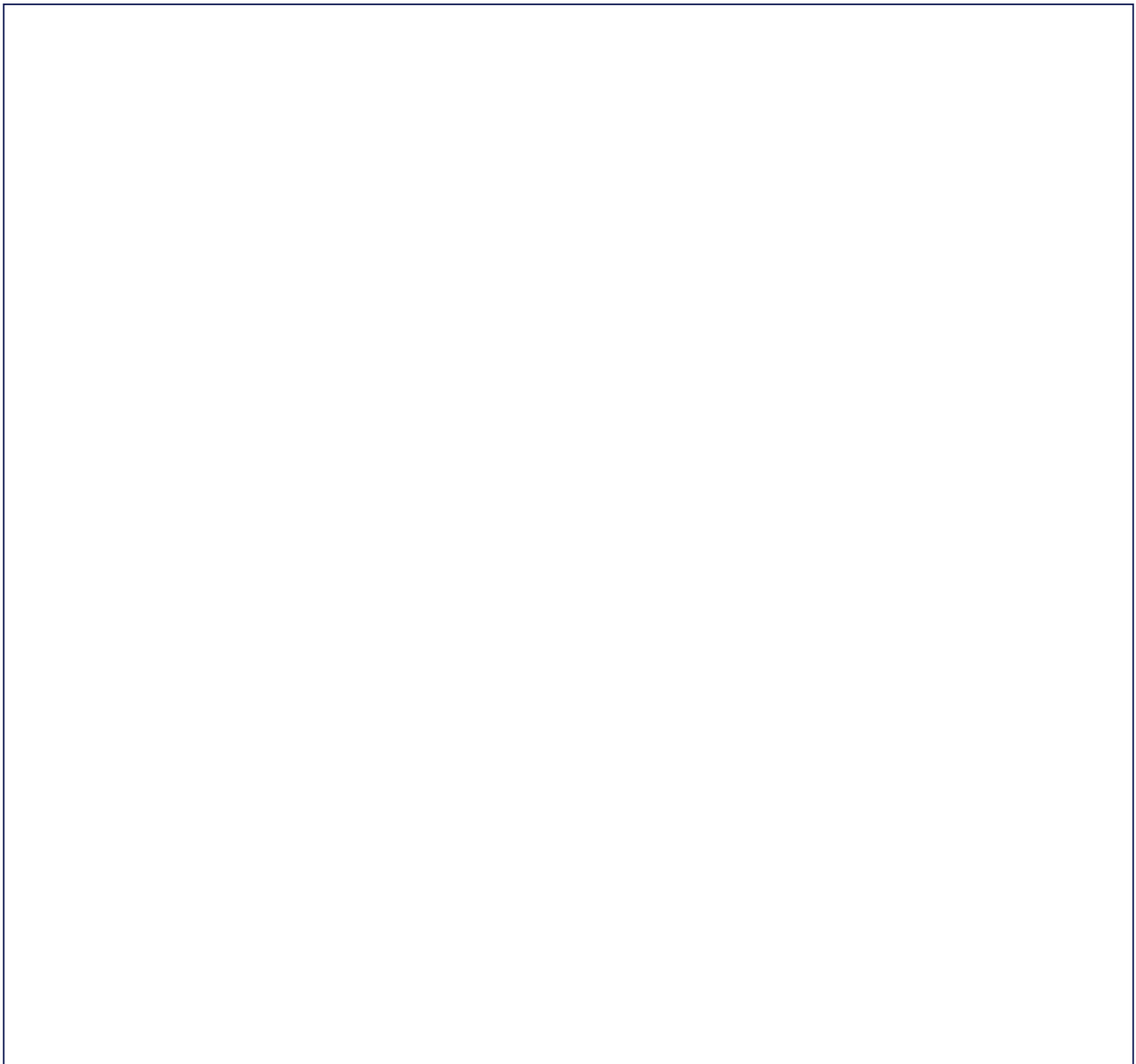


Finn's Busy Seaside Town

Learning objective: To understand that a population is a group of people living together in a place, and to recognise a seaside community.

Look at the busy seaside town. Colour in the people, the houses, and the beach. Count how many people you can see in the picture!

Colour this: A cheerful, bustling seaside scene with simple, bold outlines. In the foreground, Finn the dolphin is waving from the water. On the beach, draw four groups of people: a family building a sandcastle, an ice cream seller with a cart (a sign on the cart says 'Ice Cream £1'), a person walking a dog, and two friends playing with a ball. In the background, draw three simple houses with chimneys and a small shop. Include a bright sun in the sky and a few fluffy clouds. Ensure the lines are thick and suitable for young children to colour.



Steps:

1. Label the houses in the picture.

2. Label the people in the picture.
