

Finn's Community Map

Learning objective: To understand that people live together in communities and to represent these features in a drawing.

Finn the dolphin has travelled from the ocean to visit a local town. Help Finn understand where people live and work by drawing your own busy neighbourhood. Use the word bank to label the parts of your drawing.

Draw: Draw a bird's-eye view of a small community. Include a green park with trees, a row of colourful houses, and a small shop. Use bright colours and simple shapes like squares for houses and circles for trees. Add small stick figures to represent the people in your community.



Label words: houses · shop · park · people · road

Steps:

1. Draw two houses in your community. How many people live in each house?
2. Label the shop where people might buy food for £1 or £2.
3. Draw a path or a road to connect the houses to the park.
4. Draw two people playing in the park. Are they friends?
5. What is one thing your community has that makes it a special place to live?
