

Finn's Community Explorer Fact-File

Learning objective: To understand that people live in different places and to describe who lives in their own local community.

Finn the Dolphin travels all over the world and loves learning about the people who live in different places. Use this fact-file to explore your own community. Talk to a grown-up about who lives near you and draw a picture to match your answers.

Word bank: people · home · neighbourhood · friends · family · community · house · flat · street

1. My Neighbourhood: Who are the people that live in your street or local community? (2 marks)

2. Types of Homes: What kind of homes do people in your community live in? (e.g. houses or flats) (2 marks)

3. Special Places: What is a place in your community where people go to meet or play? (2 marks)

4. Helping Hands: Who are the people who help us in our community, like a teacher or a shopkeeper? (2 marks)

5. Finn's Question: Why is it good to have many different people living in our community? (2 marks)

Extension challenge: Go on a 'community walk' with an adult. Count how many different types of houses you see and draw a tally chart to show what you found.
