

Finn's Rainforest Adventure

Learning objective: To identify the features of a rainforest and understand that it is a place where many different plants and animals live.

Help Finn the dolphin learn about the green, leafy rainforest! Look at the words in the bank and use them to help you answer the questions below.

Finn the dolphin is exploring the world. He has found a special place called a rainforest. It is very warm and there are lots of tall trees. Many colourful birds, monkeys, and bugs live there. Because it is a rainforest, it gets lots of rain to help the plants grow big and strong.

Word bank: Rain · Trees · Green · Animals · Hot

2. What do we see lots of in a rainforest that help to make it look green? (1 mark)

3. Why do you think it is called a 'rain'forest? (2 marks)

4. If you were exploring a rainforest, name one animal you might hope to see hiding in the trees. (1 mark)

5. Tick the boxes to show what you find in a rainforest: ☐ Snow ☐ Tall trees ☐ Rain ☐ Sand (2 marks)

Draw: Draw a picture of a giant rainforest tree. Can you draw a bright bird or a funny monkey sitting in the branches?



Extension challenge: Imagine you have £5 to buy a special gift for a rainforest animal. Draw what you would buy them and explain why they would like it.
