

Finn's Ocean Rescue: Caring for Our World

Learning objective: To understand the importance of looking after our environment by recycling and reducing waste to keep our oceans and land clean.

Help Finn the dolphin keep the ocean clean! Look at the pictures and think about how we can look after our planet by reusing things, recycling, and being kind to nature.

Finn the dolphin loves to swim in the deep blue sea. Sometimes, people leave things on the beach that shouldn't be there. If we put our rubbish in the bin or use things again, we keep Finn's home clean and safe for all the sea creatures.

1. Finn finds a plastic bottle on the sand. Where is the best place to put the bottle so it does not end up in the ocean? (2 marks)

2. If you have a cardboard box, can you think of one way to reuse it instead of throwing it away? (2 marks)

3. Why is it important for us to keep our parks and beaches clean for animals like Finn? (2 marks)

4. If a toy is broken, should we put it in the bin straight away, or could we try to mend it first? (2 marks)

5. Name one thing you can do at home or school to help look after our planet. (2 marks)

Draw: Draw a picture of Finn the dolphin swimming in a clean, happy ocean. Show the water, some seaweed, and how you would help keep the beach tidy.



Extension challenge: Go on a 'Litter Hunt' in your school garden or local park with an adult. Use a clipboard to count how many pieces of rubbish you find and make sure they go into the correct bin.
