

Exploring Our United Kingdom

Learning objective: To identify that the United Kingdom is made up of four different countries and explore basic geographical features.

Look at the map and colour in the different countries. Read the facts with an adult and complete the labels below.

Colour this: A friendly, simplified map of the United Kingdom featuring four distinct landmasses (England, Scotland, Wales, and Northern Ireland). Finn the dolphin is drawn in a cartoon style, swimming in the sea near the coast of Scotland, wearing a small explorer's hat. Include simple outlines of a mountain in the north, a rolling hill in the middle, and a small town house in the south. The lines should be thick and clear for colouring. Add a compass rose in the corner showing North.



Steps:

1. Label the sea surrounding the United Kingdom.
2. Write the name of the country you live in.
