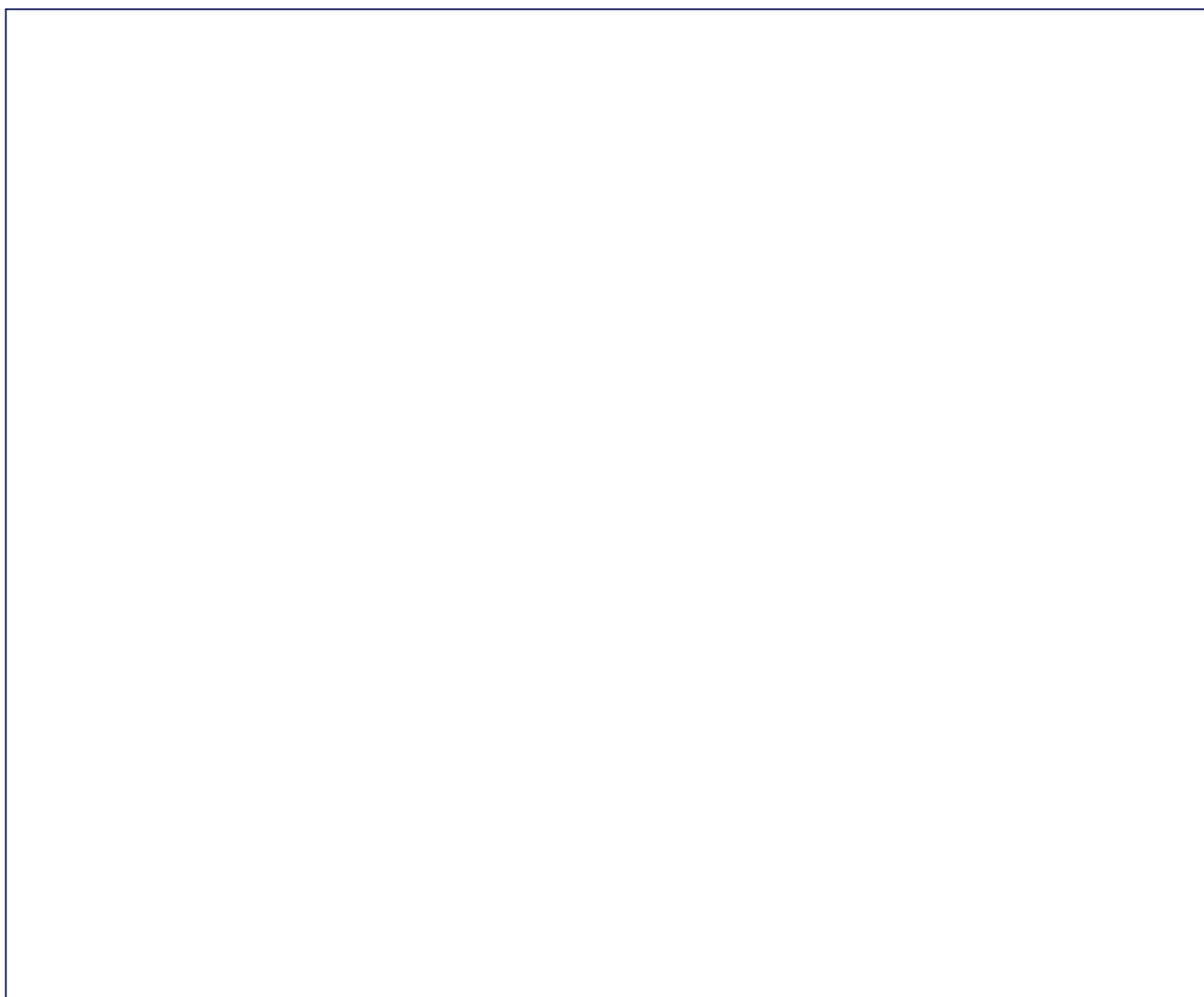


Finn's Great British Adventure

Learning objective: To identify and illustrate different features of the UK regions, such as mountains, beaches, and cities.

Finn the dolphin is travelling all around the United Kingdom! Look at the different regions he has visited. Choose one region Finn might visit and draw what you think it looks like. Use the word bank to help you label your picture.

Draw: Create a large, colourful landscape scene divided into sections. In the top corner, draw a jagged mountain peak. In the middle, draw a bustling city with tall buildings and a road. At the bottom, draw a curved coastline with a sandy beach meeting the blue sea. Use bright colours and include Finn the dolphin splashing in the waves.



Label words: mountain · beach · city · farm · sea · forest

Steps:

1. Draw a tall mountain in your picture. Is it cold or hot at the top?
2. Draw a sandy beach. Can you label the 'sea' next to the sand?
3. Name one thing you might see in a busy city.
4. Finn sees a farm. Can you draw a little fence near the farm fields?
5. Which part of your picture is your favourite? Why?
