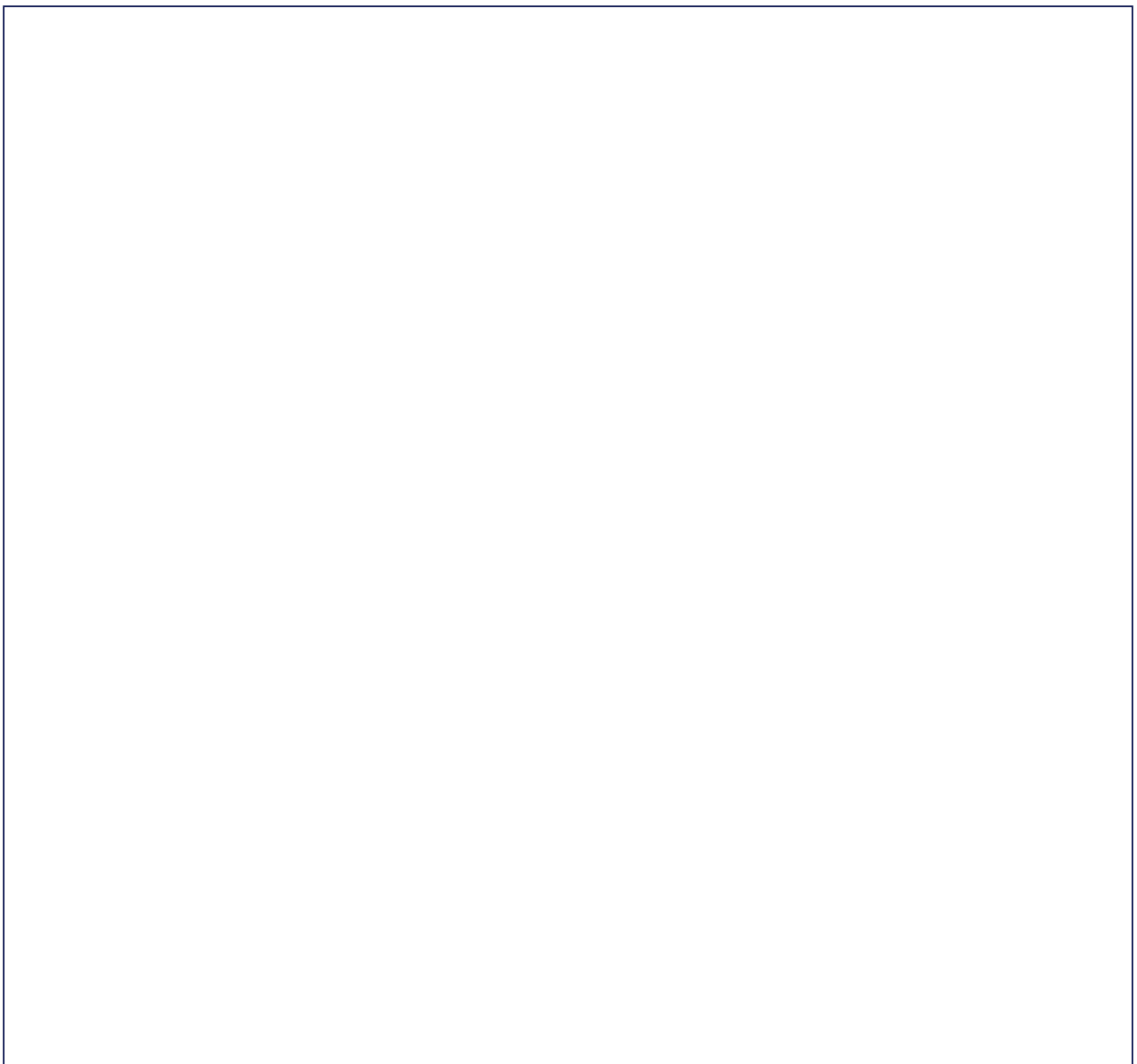


Ellie's History Lesson: The Great Fire of London

Learning objective: To understand that the Great Fire of London was a significant event from the past that changed how houses were built.

Look at the picture of the wooden houses from long ago. Use your best colours to bring the scene to life, then complete the labels at the bottom.

Colour this: A simple, clear line drawing showing a narrow street in London in 1666. There are two tall, timber-framed houses with pointed gables and small windows. One house has a sign hanging outside that says 'Bakery'. In the window of the bakery, draw simple, friendly-looking orange flames. In the bottom corner, draw a small, friendly Ellie the elephant wearing a historical explorer's hat, waving at the children. The scene should be outline-only, perfect for colouring.



Steps:

1. Label the roof of the wooden house.
2. Label the flames coming from the bakery window.
