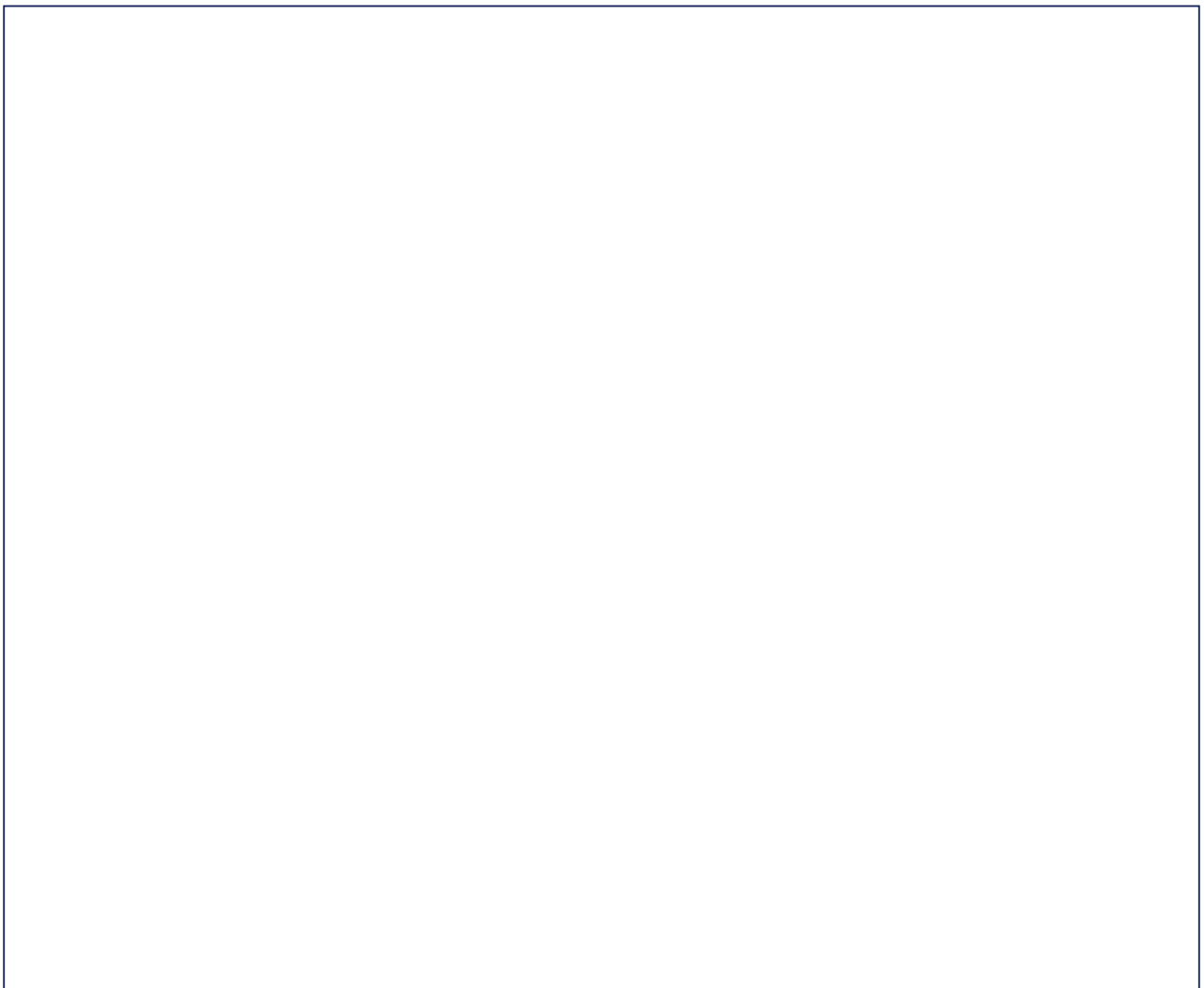


Remembrance Day with Ellie the Elephant

Learning objective: To understand the significance of Remembrance Day as a time to remember people who helped us in the past and to recognise symbols like the poppy.

Ellie the Elephant is learning about history today. She wants to show her respect for Remembrance Day. Use this sheet to draw a special scene to show that we remember those who were brave. Follow the steps to add important things to your picture.

Draw: Draw a large, bright red poppy in the centre of the page. Around the poppy, draw a grassy field. In the sky above, you can draw a soft yellow sun or a white dove to represent peace. Use bright colours to show that this is a time to think about people with love and kindness. The style should be simple, using clear shapes that are easy for young children to colour.



Label words: Poppy · Field · Love · Peace · Remember

Steps:

1. Step 1: In the middle of your page, draw a bright red poppy flower. What shape are the petals?
2. Step 2: Draw a green stem and some leaves underneath your poppy.
3. Step 3: Draw a peaceful sky above the field. What colour will you make the sky?
4. Step 4: Label your drawing using one of the words from the word bank.

5. Step 5: Why do we wear a poppy on Remembrance Day? Talk to a friend about your answer.
