

Max's Christmas Market Maths

Learning objective: To practise counting, shape recognition, and simple addition in a festive context.

Max the monkey is helping at the Christmas market! Help him get the market stall ready by drawing the items and solving the maths puzzles below.

Draw: Draw a large Christmas market stall in the centre of the page. On the stall, draw two round red baubles, one large yellow star, and three square presents wrapped with ribbons. Next to the stall, draw Max the monkey holding a small purse. Use bright, festive colours and keep the shapes clear and simple.



Label words: bauble · star · present · wreath · coin

Steps:

1. Max has 2 round baubles. Draw 1 more bauble. How many baubles are there altogether?
2. A star costs £1. A present costs £2. If you buy both, how much money do you need in total?
3. Look at your wreath drawing. How many sides does a triangle shape have?
4. If Max has three £1 coins, circle the coins you would use to pay for a £2 present.
5. Draw a pattern on your present using two different colours. Which colours did you choose?
