3. 3. Write the fraction 6/10 as a decimal. (1 mark)

4. 4. Which of these numbers is the smallest? A) 0.25, B) 0.205, C) 0.5, D) 0.52. Answer: *B (1 mark)

5. 5. True or False: If you round 0.46 to the nearest tenth, you get 0.4. (1 mark)

6. 6. Max buys a snack for £0.52. Write this amount in pounds. (1 mark)

7. 7. What is 35/100 as a decimal? (1 mark)

8. 8. Complete the sequence: 0.1, 0.3, 0.5, ... (1 mark)

9. 9. Max finds 1 whole and 25 hundredths of a metre of rope. Write this as a decimal. (1 mark)

10. 10. Which is equivalent to 60/100? A) 0.06, B) 6.0, C) 0.6, D) 0.006. Answer: *C (1 mark)
