

Max the Monkey's Easter Egg Hunt

Learning objective: To solve simple addition and subtraction problems using money (£) and counting skills within the context of an Easter shop.

Help Max the Monkey count the Easter treats! Read the price labels for each item. In the boxes below, show how much you spend, how much change you have, and draw your favourite treats. Work with a grown-up to add up the total cost of your Easter basket.

Word bank: total · pence · pounds · add · take away · cost · change · price

1. My Easter Shopping List: Write down two items you want to buy and the price of each item in pence (p). (2 marks)

2. Adding it Up: Write the sum to find the total cost of your two items (e.g., $5p + 3p = 8p$). (2 marks)

3. Paying the Shopkeeper: If you have a 10p coin, how much change would you get back after buying your items? (2 marks)

4. Easter Patterns: Zara the Zebra has 4 spotted eggs and 3 striped eggs. How many eggs does she have altogether? (2 marks)

5. Max's Challenge: Max has £5. He spends £2 on chocolate treats. How many pounds does he have left? (2 marks)

Extension challenge: Ask a friend to choose three items from the shop. Can you work out which item is the most expensive and which is the cheapest?
