

Max's Market Stall Challenge

Learning objective: To recognise, total, and compare the values of coins and notes in pounds (£) and pence (p).

Max the monkey is opening a fruit stall! Use this record sheet to help Max count his money. Look at the items for sale, choose your coins, and calculate the total cost. Write clearly and remember to use the £ or p symbol.

Word bank: total · coins · pence · pounds · cost · change · value · add

1. My Fruit Shop List: Write down three items you want to sell at your stall and how much each one costs in pence (p). (3 marks)

2. The Total Cost: Choose two items from your list. Add their prices together to find the total cost. Show your working out. (2 marks)

3. Coin Collection: Draw or list the coins you would use to pay for an item that costs 20p. Which coins did you choose? (2 marks)

4. Pounds and Pence: If you have a £1 coin, and you spend 50p, how much money do you have left? Write your answer in pence. (2 marks)

5. Max's Challenge: Max has a £2 coin. Can he afford to buy a bunch of bananas for £1 and an apple for 50p? Explain how you know. (3 marks)

Extension challenge: Imagine you have £5. List three things you would buy from the shop and calculate if you have enough money left over to buy a small treat!
