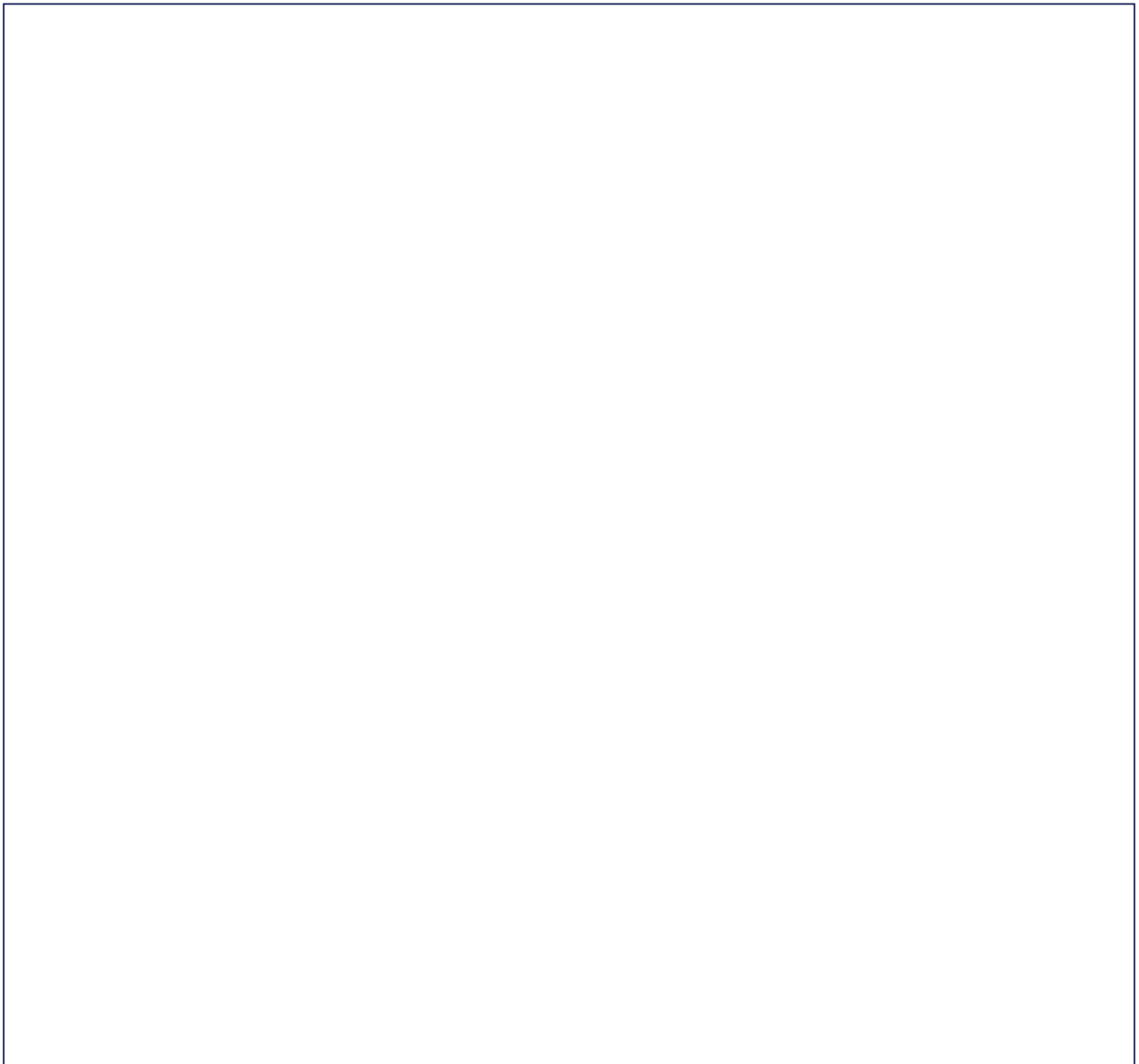


Max the Monkey's Multiplication Market

Learning objective: To recognise and represent multiplication as repeated addition and equal groups (Year 1).

Help Max the Monkey count his fruit! Look at the groups of fruit, colour them in, and write the matching number sentences to show the total.

Colour this: A friendly monkey named Max wearing a small apron standing behind a wooden market stall. On the stall, draw two clear groups of 5 bananas and three clear groups of 2 apples. Use bold, thick outlines for the fruit so they are easy for children to colour. Max is holding a chalkboard with an empty space to write a number. The background is a simple, sunny park scene.



Steps:

1. Label the groups of bananas in the picture. If there are 2 groups of 5 bananas, write the total number of bananas here:
2. Label the groups of apples. If there are 3 groups of 2 apples, write the total number of apples here:
