Max's Magic Numbers: Where does your digit live?

- A digit is a single number symbol, like 0, 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, or 9.
- The 'Tens' column is on the left side. It shows how many groups of ten we have.
- The 'Ones' column is on the right side. It shows the extra bits that are left over.
- If you have 1 ten and 3 ones, you have the number 13.
- Changing the position of a number changes its total value completely!

Did you know? Did you know? In the number 12, the '1' isn't just one—it is worth ten! Max the monkey loves counting bananas in groups of ten to keep his jungle maths tidy.
