Learning objective: To identify, represent and estimate numbers using different representations, including the number line, and use the language of equal to, more than, less than (fewer), most and least.

9. If you have 10 and add 2, what is the total? (1 mark)

10. Which number is written as 'eighty-six'? A) 86*, B) 68, C) 80, D) 6 (1 mark)
