

Max's Roman Numeral Challenge

Learning objective: To recognise, read, and write Roman numerals up to 100 (C) and understand their place in history.

Max the monkey has found a collection of ancient stone tablets! Help him decipher the symbols by matching the Roman numerals to their decimal values. Use these flashcards to test your knowledge.

What is the decimal value of the Roman numeral I?	What is the decimal value of the Roman numeral V?
1	5
What is the decimal value of the Roman numeral X?	What is the decimal value of the Roman numeral L?
10	50
What is the decimal value of the Roman numeral C?	What is the Roman numeral for 4?
100	IV (5 minus 1)
What is the Roman numeral for 9?	What is the Roman numeral for 40?
IX (10 minus 1)	XL (50 minus 10)
What is the Roman numeral for 90?	Convert the Roman numeral XVI into a decimal number.
XC (100 minus 10)	16 (10 + 5 + 1)
Convert the Roman numeral LXXV into a decimal number.	Convert the Roman numeral XCIX into a decimal number.
75 (50 + 10 + 10 + 5)	99 (90 + 9)
