Learning objective: To understand and identify different musical tempos and their Italian terminology.

Help Max the monkey sort out his musical puzzle! Read each question carefully and circle the best answer. Remember, tempo is the speed at which a piece of music is played.

Answer Key: 1.C, 2.True, 3.Largo, 4.B, 5.False, 6.Presto, 7.A, 8.True, 9.Andante, 10.B. Note: BPM stands for Beats Per Minute.

5. 5. True or False: 'Andante' means the music should be played as fast as a racing car. (1 mark)

6. 6. Which term describes the fastest tempo of all, often meaning 'very quick'? (Write one word) (1 mark)

7. 7. If you see 'BPM' on a piece of music, what does it stand for? A) Beats Per Minute* B) Bars Per Measure C) Big Percussion Music D) Basic Play Mode (1 mark)

8. 8. True or False: A piece of music can change its tempo halfway through. (1 mark)

9. 9. Which tempo describes a 'walking pace'? (Write one word) (1 mark)

10. 10. Which of these is a slow, relaxed tempo? A) Presto B) Adagio* C) Allegro D) Vivace (1 mark)
