

Kindness Catch-Up with Leo the Lion

Learning objective: To understand the qualities of a good friend and demonstrate how to show kindness towards others.

Leo the Lion wants to be a great friend to everyone in the jungle. Look at the list of actions below. Decide if each action is a 'Kind Choice' or a 'Thoughtful Choice' that helps build a friendship. Draw a smiley face next to the actions that show a good friend, and a thinking face next to the actions that help us solve a problem with a friend.

1. Your friend is sad because they dropped their ice cream. What could you say to help them feel better? (2 marks)

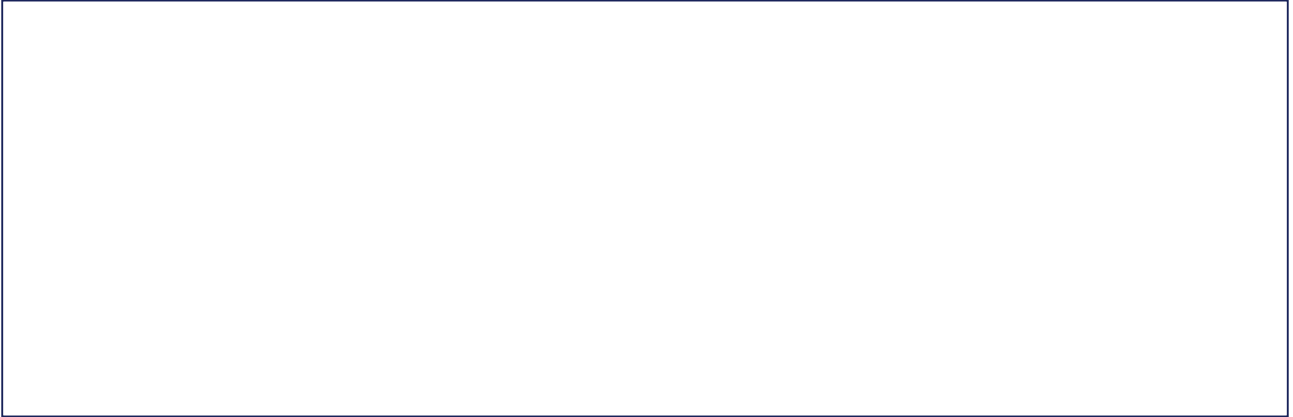
2. You and Max the Monkey both want to play with the same toy. What is a kind way to solve this? (2 marks)

4. If you accidentally bump into someone, what are the best words to use? (2 marks)

5. How can you show a new child in class that they are welcome to join your game? (2 marks)
