

Kit's Digital Detective Sorting Activity

Learning objective: To help children understand how to stay safe online by identifying who they should talk to and what personal information should be kept private.

Kit the fox has found some digital information. Look at the items in the list below. Draw a line from each item to either the 'Safe to Share' basket or the 'Keep Private' box. Talk to your teacher or grown-up about why some things are just for you.

Word bank: Full name · Favourite colour · Home address · School name · Favourite animal · Password

1. 1. Is it okay to share your home address with a stranger on a tablet? Why? (2 marks)

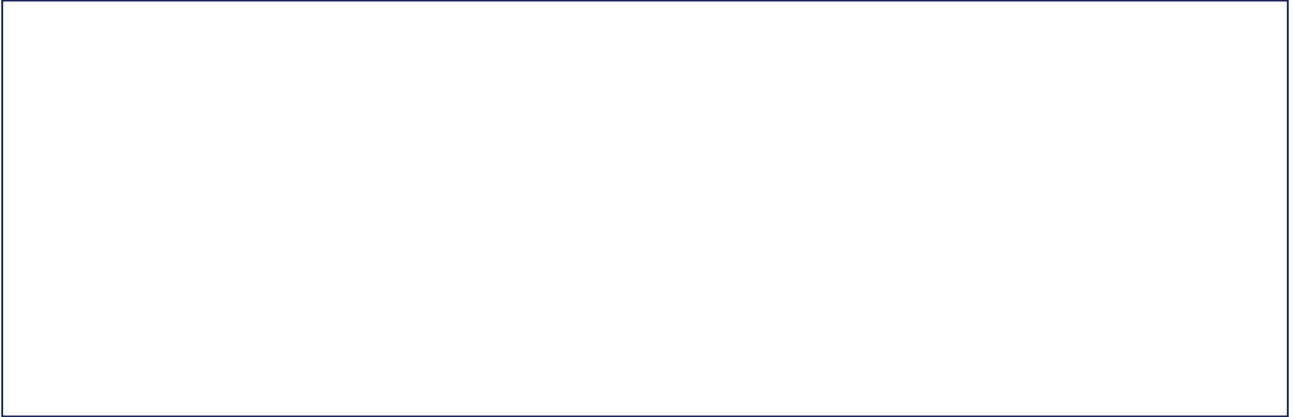
2. 2. If a game asks for your password, what should you do? (2 marks)

3. 3. Who is the first person you should tell if you see something on a screen that makes you feel worried or sad? (2 marks)

4. 4. Is your favourite colour safe to tell a friend online? (2 marks)

5. 5. Why should we keep our full name a secret from people we don't know? (2 marks)

Draw: Draw a picture of yourself using a tablet or computer in a shared space, like your living room, with a grown-up nearby to help you stay safe.



Extension challenge: Create a 'Safe Online Promise' poster with Kit the fox. Write down one rule you will follow, such as 'I will always ask a grown-up before I click on something new'.
