

Staying Safe in the Digital World with Kit the Fox

Learning objective: To identify the importance of online safety and recognise how to protect personal information when using digital devices.

Follow the drawing prompts below to create a guide for staying safe online. Use the word bank to label your finished work.

Draw: Create a clear, colourful scene showing a safe digital workspace. Include Kit the Fox in the corner giving a 'thumbs up'. Use clear lines to draw a tablet screen. Ensure there is enough space around the device to draw labels and arrows connecting your drawings to the terms in the word bank.



Label words: Private Information · Secure Password · Trusted Adult · Privacy Settings · Report · Digital Footprint

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw a digital device (like a tablet or laptop) in the centre. Inside the screen, draw three things that count as 'Private Information' (e.g., home address, school name, phone number).
2. Step 2: Draw a shield next to your device. Label the shield with a 'Secure Password' tip, such as using a mix of letters, numbers, and symbols.
3. Step 3: Draw Kit the Fox pointing to a 'Trusted Adult'. Why should you talk to them if you see something

online that worries you?

4. Step 4: Draw a small 'Report' button on your screen. Explain what this button does if you encounter unkind behaviour online.

5. Step 5: Label the area around your device as your 'Digital Footprint'. Why is it important to be kind and careful with what you post?
