

Learning about Buddhism with Ellie the Elephant

Learning objective: To introduce children to the symbols and peaceful nature of Buddhism, fostering respect and understanding of diverse beliefs.

Talk about how Ellie is learning about kindness. Colour in the picture carefully and see if you can label the special items Ellie has found.

Colour this: A large, friendly elephant named Ellie sitting peacefully on a soft mat in a bright, airy room. In front of her, there is a large, open lotus flower resting on a wooden table.
