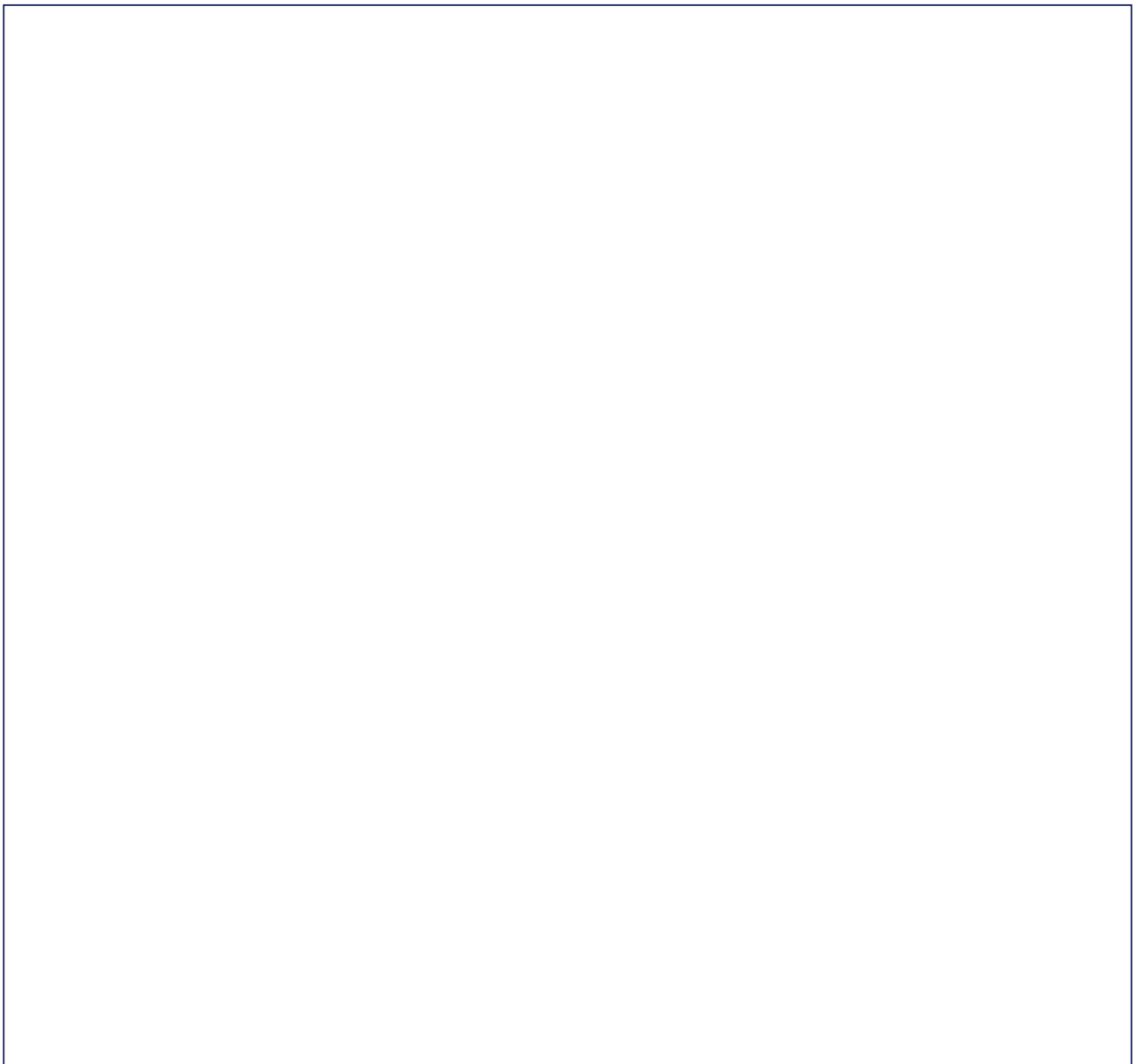


A Kind Welcome: Learning about Church

Learning objective: To recognise that a church is a special place for Christians to gather and worship.

Look at the picture of the church building. Colour the stained glass windows with bright colours. Draw a flower in the garden near the door. Talk to an adult about why people go to a church.
