

Exploring Christian Traditions with Pip the Caterpillar

Learning objective: To understand that Christians believe in God and celebrate special times like Christmas and Easter.

Read the questions with your grown-up and talk about the special things Christians do. Write or draw your answers in the spaces provided.

Word bank: Church · Bible · Christmas · Easter · God · Love · Kindness

1. Pip the caterpillar is visiting a church. Can you name one thing you might see inside a church? (1 mark)

2. Christians believe that God created the world. What is one beautiful thing in nature that you think is special? (2 marks)

3. At Christmas, Christians celebrate the birth of Jesus. What is one way people show love to their friends at Christmas time? (2 marks)

4. Easter is a time for new beginnings. Why do you think people give eggs as a symbol at Easter? (2 marks)

5. The Bible is a very special book for Christians. If you were writing a story about being kind, what would your title be? (2 marks)

Draw: Draw a picture of a church or a nativity scene, showing how Pip the caterpillar might celebrate a special Christian festival.



Extension challenge: Talk to a friend about a special time your family celebrates. How is it the same or different to the celebrations Christians have?
