Learning objective: To identify and explain core Christian beliefs and the significance of key practices, as per the Year 5 RE curriculum.

1. The Nature of God: Explain the concept of the Trinity and what it means to Christians. (3 marks)

2. Core Beliefs: Describe the importance of the life and teachings of Jesus, including the idea of salvation. (3 marks)

3. Sacraments: Choose one sacrament, such as Baptism or the Eucharist, and explain what happens and why it is significant. (3 marks)

4. Christian Living: How might a Christian show their faith through their actions in everyday life? (2 marks)

5. Reflection: Why do you think Christians find it important to belong to a church community? (2 marks)

Extension challenge: Research a specific Christian festival (such as Easter or Christmas) and write a short paragraph explaining the history behind it and how it is celebrated by families today.
