

Nova's Wonderful World Sorting Activity

Learning objective: To understand the concept of creation by sorting elements of the natural world into categories representing the sky, the land, and the sea.

Nova the owl has been looking at the world from the stars and wants to know how everything fits together! Look at the list of items in the word bank. Cut them out or write them down in the correct column: The Sky, The Land, or The Sea. Think about where each thing belongs in the story of our beautiful world.

Word bank: Sun · Whale · Tree · Cloud · Flower · Fish · Star · Mountain · Crab

1. Which item from the word bank lives in the deep blue sea? Write your answer here. (1 mark)

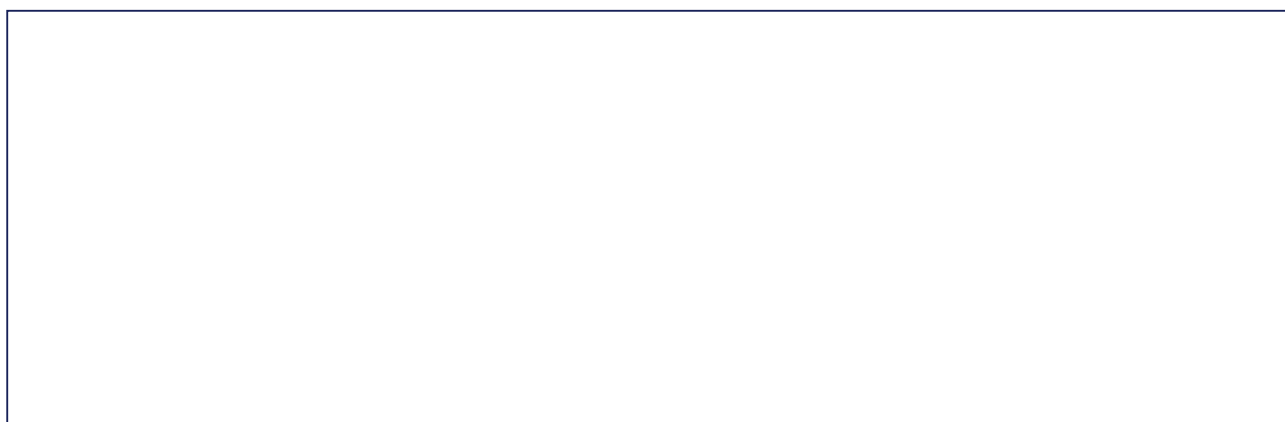
2. Can you name one thing that shines in the sky during the day? (1 mark)

3. Why do you think trees and flowers are important to have on the land? (2 marks)

4. If you could add one more thing to the world, what would it be and where would you put it? (2 marks)

5. Does the star belong in the sky, on the land, or in the sea? (1 mark)

Draw: Draw a picture of your favourite part of the world. It could be a bright sun in the sky, a tall tree on a hill, or a friendly fish swimming in the ocean. Make it colourful!



Extension challenge: Talk to a friend about why it is important to look after our world, like keeping the sea clean for the fish and the land tidy for the flowers.
