*Learning objective: To learn about the signs of spring and the traditions of Easter while developing fine motor skills through colouring.*

Welcome to the garden! Bea the honeybee is getting ready for spring. Colour the scene carefully. Once you have finished your beautiful artwork, label the parts of the garden as asked below.
