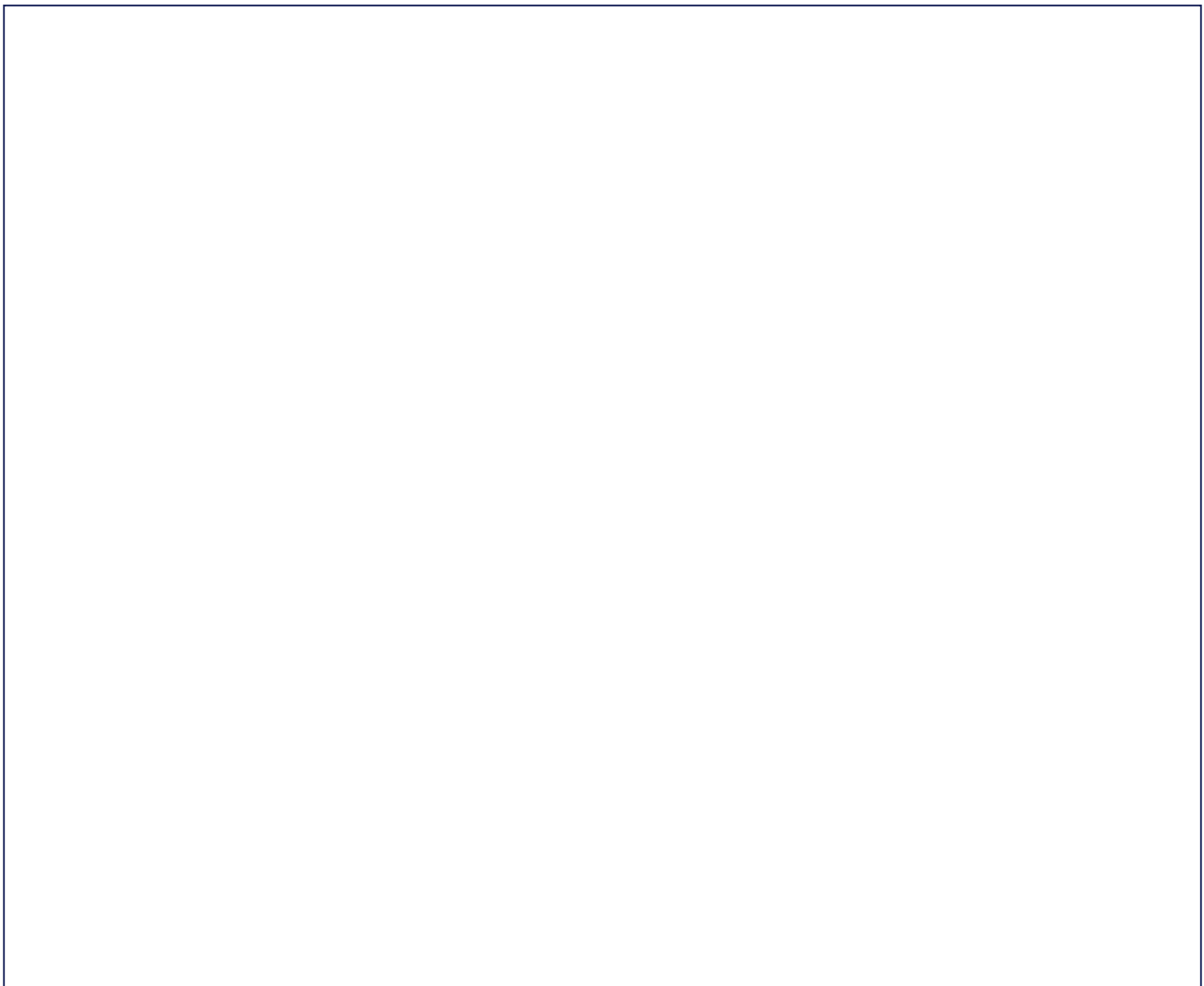


Celebrating Special Times with Zara

Learning objective: To explore how festivals are celebrated by different people and express understanding through drawing and labelling.

Today, Zara the zebra is visiting a festival celebration. Look at the word bank and think about what makes a festival special, like bright colours, delicious food, or decorations. Use the space below to draw your favourite celebration scene, then try to label your drawing using the words provided.

Draw: Draw a large, cheerful festival scene. Include a table with some special festival food, colourful bunting or lights hanging above, and people (or Zara the zebra!) enjoying music together. The style should be bright, bold, and welcoming, using plenty of shapes and patterns.



Label words: lights · food · family · colours · music

Steps:

1. Draw a picture of a festival celebration in the box below. Include at least two things from the word bank in your drawing.
2. Which of the words from the word bank did you choose to draw? Write them here.
3. If you were buying a special treat at the festival, would you spend £1 or £10? Circle your answer.
4. Tell a friend why your festival drawing is a happy time.

5. Look at your drawing. Can you point to the colours you used and name them out loud?
