

Making Kind Choices with Leo the Lion

Learning objective: To understand the difference between kind and unkind choices and learn how to make positive decisions that help others.

Read the scenarios with your teacher or grown-up. Think about how Leo the Lion would act, then answer the questions to show how you can be a kind friend.

Word bank: Kind · Share · Help · Listen · Sorry · Friend

1. Max the monkey has dropped his fruit. What is the kind thing to do? (2 marks)

2. You want to play with the same toy as your friend. How can you solve this problem fairly? (2 marks)

3. Your friend is feeling sad because they fell over. What could you say to them? (2 marks)

4. If you accidentally break something that belongs to someone else, what is the best thing to do? (2 marks)

5. Why does it make us feel good when we help someone else? (2 marks)

Draw: Draw a picture of you and Leo the Lion doing something kind together, like helping a friend or sharing a toy.



Extension challenge: Imagine you have £1 to spend at a pretend shop. Would you buy one treat for yourself, or two smaller treats to share with a friend? Explain why you made your choice.
