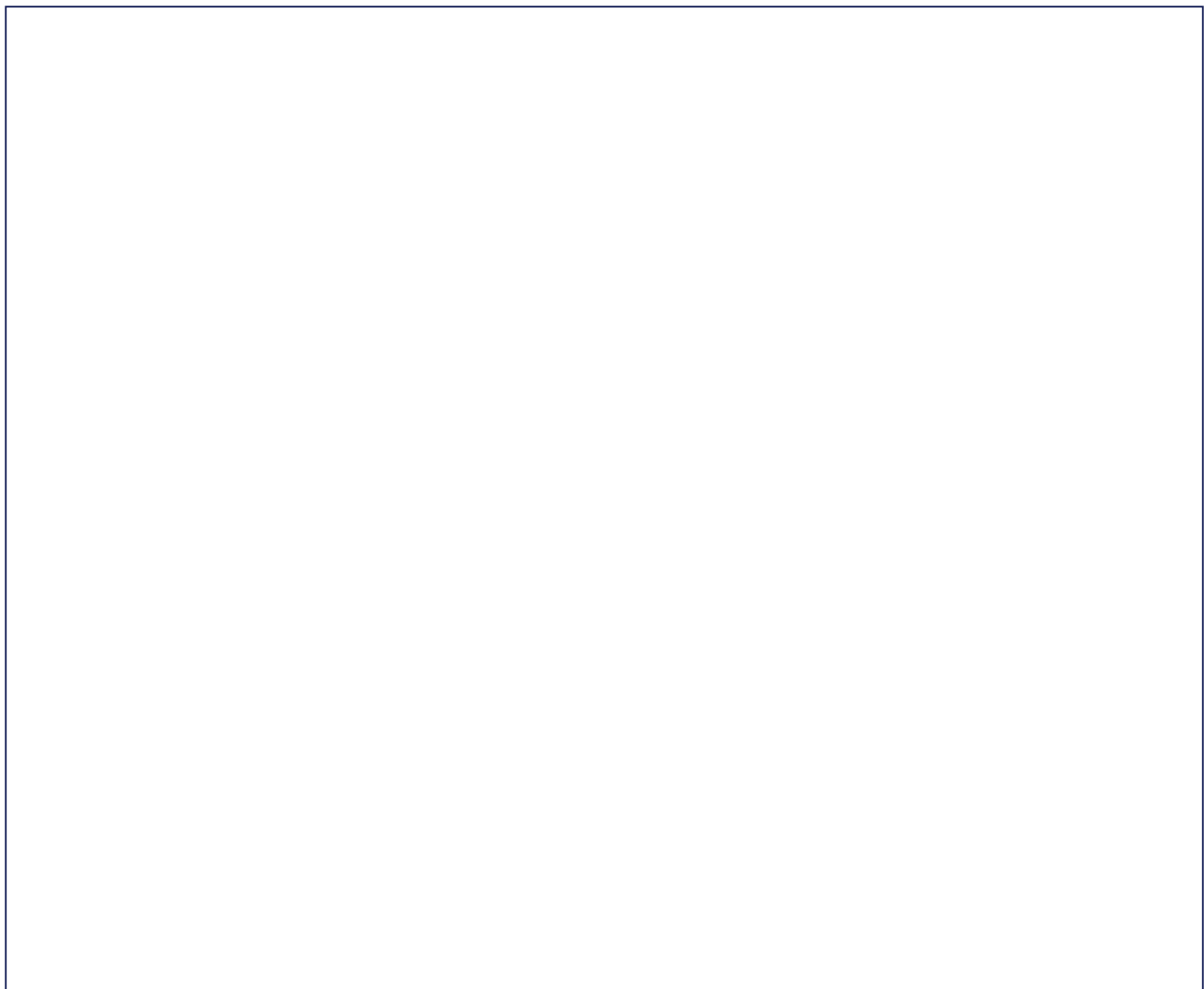


## Exploring Moral Choices with Leo the Lion

*Learning objective: To identify and reflect on moral dilemmas, considering how different actions affect others.*

Leo the Lion is helping the forest animals decide the fairest way to share the harvest. Read the scenarios below and draw your solutions in the space provided. Use the word bank to help label your drawings.

**Draw: Draw a scene in the forest featuring Leo the Lion standing near a large basket of fruit. Show Leo interacting with other forest animals (like a squirrel or a bird). Include speech bubbles showing the animals discussing how to share the fruit. Use clear, colourful lines. Add labels to your drawing using the provided word bank to show where you have depicted 'fairness' and 'kindness'.**



*Label words: consequences · fairness · empathy · kindness · responsibility · moral choice*

### Steps:

1. Identify one 'moral choice' Leo makes in your drawing. Why is this a kind decision?
2. What might be the 'consequences' if Leo decided to keep all the fruit for himself?
3. How does 'empathy' help Leo understand how the other animals are feeling?
4. If two animals both need the fruit, how can Leo use 'fairness' to solve the problem?
5. Why is it important to consider the 'responsibility' we have towards others?
