

Ellie's Special Story Boxes

Learning objective: To recognise that different religions have special books that contain important stories and teachings.

Ellie the elephant is helping us learn about how different people value their special books. Look at the names of the sacred books in the word bank and match them to the correct religion. Then, draw a line to connect the book to the place where people might read it.

Word bank: Bible · Qur'an · Torah · Guru Granth Sahib · Christianity · Islam · Judaism · Sikhism

1. Which religion uses the Bible? Draw a line from 'Bible' to 'Christianity'. (2 marks)

2. Which religion uses the Qur'an? Draw a line from 'Qur'an' to 'Islam'. (2 marks)

3. Which religion uses the Torah? Draw a line from 'Torah' to 'Judaism'. (2 marks)

4. Which religion uses the Guru Granth Sahib? Draw a line from 'Guru Granth Sahib' to 'Sikhism'. (2 marks)

5. Why do you think people keep these books in a special place? Talk to a friend about your idea. (2 marks)

Draw: Draw a picture of a special book that is important to your family or a book you love to read. Make sure to draw a beautiful cover for it!



Extension challenge: Ask your grown-up if you can visit a library or a bookshop. Can you find a book that teaches people how to be kind or how to look after the world?
