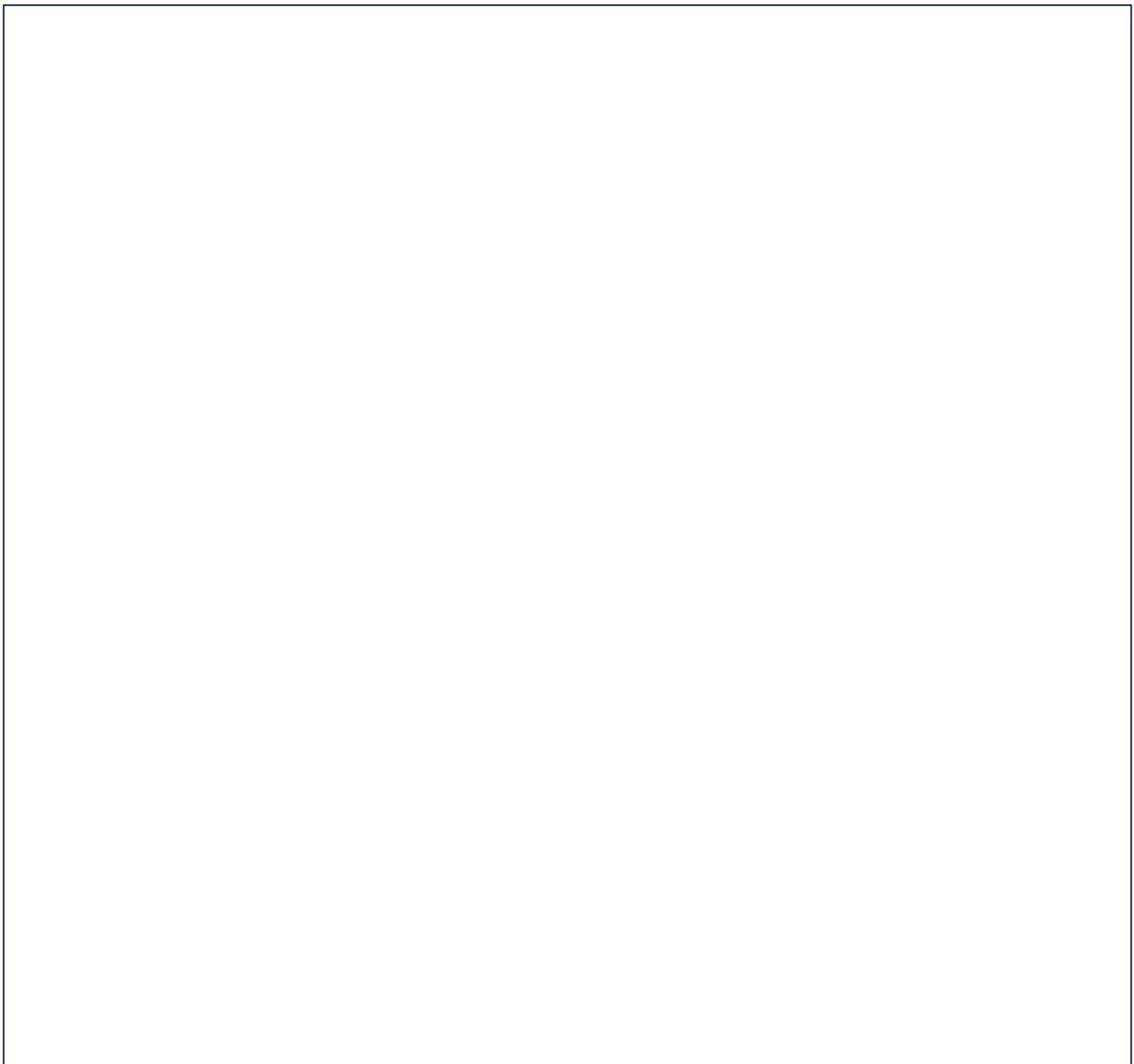


A Visit to the Gurdwara with Ellie the Elephant

Learning objective: To learn about the Sikh place of worship and the importance of kindness and community.

Hello! Today we are learning about a special place called a Gurdwara. Use your favourite colours to bring this scene to life. Remember to draw patterns on the floor coverings!
