

Nova's Galactic Guide: Our Solar System

- **The Sun is a star at the centre of our solar system, and eight planets, including Earth, orbit around it.**
- **The Earth takes approximately 365 days to complete one full orbit around the Sun, which creates our calendar year.**
- **The Moon is a celestial body that orbits the Earth, taking about 28 days to complete one full cycle.**
- **Gravity is the invisible force that keeps the planets in their orbits and keeps us firmly on the ground.**
- **Planets, stars, and moons are spherical in shape because their own gravity pulls matter towards their centre.**

Did you know? Did you know? Even though it feels like we are standing still, the Earth is spinning on its axis at a speed of about 1,000 miles per hour! Because of this constant rotation, we experience day and night as different parts of the world face towards or away from the Sun.
