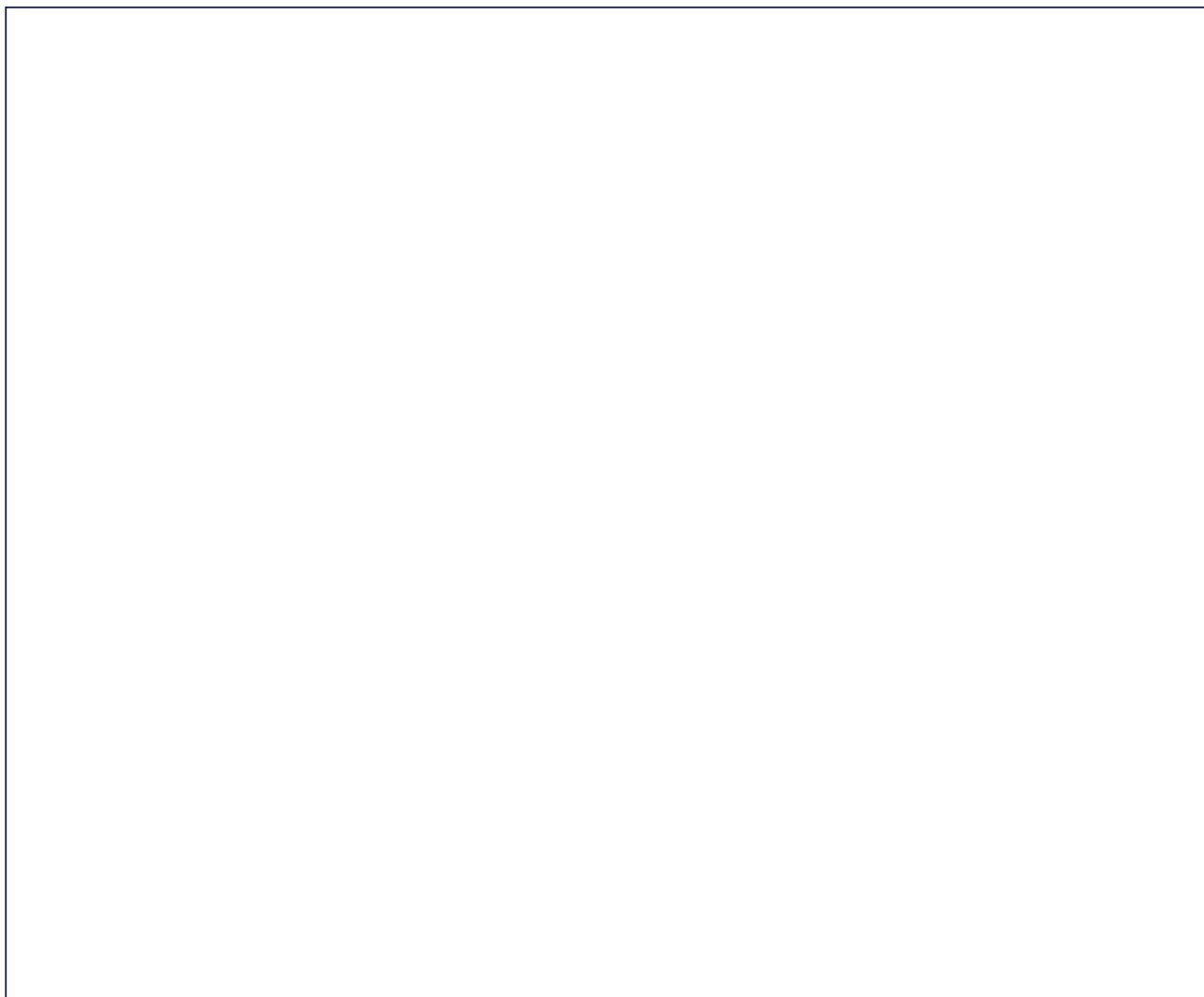


Rosa's Spanish Wardrobe

Learning objective: To identify and use Spanish vocabulary for items of clothing and describe personal preferences.

Rosa the parrot is getting ready for a sunny holiday in Spain! Use the word bank to help you complete the drawing task and answer the questions below.

Draw: Draw a full-length portrait of Rosa the parrot standing in a park. Draw Rosa wearing at least three different items of clothing from the word bank. Make the clothes colourful and use clear lines. Add a label with an arrow pointing to each item of clothing using the correct Spanish term.



Label words: la camiseta (t-shirt) · los pantalones (trousers) · la falda (skirt) · el vestido (dress) · los zapatos (shoes) · el sombrero (hat)

Steps:

1. Label the three items of clothing you have drawn on Rosa in your picture using the Spanish words from the word bank.
2. If a shirt costs £12 and a hat costs £5, how much would they cost altogether? Write the total in pounds.
3. Translate this sentence into English: 'Llevo una camiseta.'
4. Which item of clothing would you wear if it was a very cold day in Spain? Write your answer in Spanish.

5. Write a short sentence in Spanish describing one thing Rosa is wearing (e.g., 'Rosa lleva...').
