

Rosa's Wardrobe Fact-File: Mi Ropa

Learning objective: To identify and describe items of clothing in Spanish, using appropriate vocabulary and adjectives.

Rosa the parrot is getting ready for a trip around the world! Use this fact-file to help her organise her suitcase. In each section, write the Spanish word for the clothing item and describe it using an adjective (e.g., 'rojo' for red or 'grande' for big).

Word bank: la camiseta (t-shirt) · los pantalones (trousers) · el vestido (dress) · la chaqueta (jacket) · los zapatos (shoes) · el sombrero (hat) · azul (blue) · rojo (red) · verde (green) · amarillo (yellow)

1. Top Half: Choose an item for Rosa to wear on her wings or body. Write the Spanish name and a colour adjective. (2 marks)

2. Bottom Half: Choose an item for Rosa's legs. Write the Spanish name and a colour adjective. (2 marks)

3. Footwear: Write the Spanish word for shoes and describe them (e.g., are they big or small?). (2 marks)

4. Accessories: Choose a hat or scarf. Write the Spanish name and explain why she needs it. (3 marks)

5. Complete Sentence: Write one full sentence in Spanish describing your favourite outfit from the list (e.g., 'Yo llevo un vestido rojo'). (3 marks)

Extension challenge: Imagine Rosa is travelling to a very cold country. Can you write a short list of three items she should pack, using Spanish nouns and the word 'para' (for) or 'necesita' (she needs)?
