

# Los Colores: Rosa's Rainbow Classroom

Join Rosa the parrot on a vibrant journey to master the colours of the world!

- How do you say 'The yellow sun' in Spanish? (Clue: El sol es amarillo)
- Which Spanish colour sounds similar to the English word for a citrus fruit?
- Why do you think Rosa uses the word 'Morado' for purple and not 'Violeta'?
- What is the key difference between 'Rojo' and 'Blanco' in terms of light and dark?
- How can you use the word 'Verde' to describe nature in a Spanish sentence?

*Did you know? Did you know? In Spanish, most colour adjectives must 'agree' with the noun they describe! If you are talking about a masculine noun (like 'el libro' - the book), the colour stays the same. But if the noun is feminine (like 'la mesa' - the table) and ends in 'o', you often change the 'o' to an 'a' to match it!*
