

Rosa's Colourful Garden

Learning objective: To identify and use Spanish vocabulary for colours to describe items in a creative scene.

Rosa the parrot is helping you design a beautiful garden! Read the Spanish colour names in the word bank and follow the drawing steps to bring the garden to life. Remember to label your drawings in Spanish.

Draw: Create a vibrant garden scene on a blank sheet of paper. Include a large flower, a butterfly, a bird, the sky, and Rosa the parrot. Use the vocabulary from the word bank to add colour labels to each item you draw. Use a bright, cheerful artistic style like a colourful nature sketchbook.



Label words: rojo (red) · azul (blue) · amarillo (yellow) · verde (green) · naranja (orange) · morado (purple) · rosa (pink) · blanco (white) · negro (black)

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw a large flower with petals of two different colours. Label the colours in Spanish.
2. Step 2: Draw a butterfly flying near the flower. Use the word 'naranja' to describe one part of it.
3. Step 3: Draw the sky above the garden. Write the Spanish word for blue in the sky.
4. Step 4: Draw a small bird. Label it with the Spanish word for black (negro) or white (blanco).
5. Step 5: Rosa is hiding in the garden. Draw her and label her feathers using the word 'verde'.
