

Rosa's Busy Week in Spain

Learning objective: To identify and understand the days of the week in Spanish within a short text.

Read the passage about Rosa the parrot's busy week in Spain. Use the word bank to help you answer the questions below.

Rosa the parrot loves flying across the sunny skies of Spain. She has a very busy schedule! On lunes, she visits the colourful markets to find fresh fruit. By martes, she is ready to practise her singing in the olive groves. On miércoles, she meets her friends to share stories. She always spends jueves helping the local children learn new words. When viernes arrives, Rosa flies to the coast to watch the fishing boats return. She loves the weekend! On sábado, she spends the whole day painting patterns on the rocks near the sea. Finally, on domingo, she rests her wings and watches the sunset. Rosa says that every day is special when you have a plan. She thinks the most exciting day is sábado because she can be so creative. Whether it is a busy school day or a relaxing weekend, Rosa is always happy to share her week with everyone she meets.

Word bank: lunes (Monday) · martes (Tuesday) · miércoles (Wednesday) · jueves (Thursday) · viernes (Friday) · sábado (Saturday) · domingo (Sunday)

1. On which day does Rosa visit the market, and on which day does she go to the coast? (2 marks)

2. What does Rosa do on miércoles according to the text? (2 marks)

3. Why might Rosa choose to rest on domingo? (2 marks)

4. What does the text suggest about Rosa's personality based on her weekly activities? (2 marks)

5. Rosa says sábado is the most exciting day. Do you think a busy day or a relaxing day makes for a better week? Justify your answer. (3 marks)

Draw: Draw a calendar for one week. In each box, draw a small picture representing what Rosa does on that specific day (e.g., fruit on Lunes, paint on Sábado).



Extension challenge: Can you write a sentence in Spanish about what you like to do on a specific day of the week? Use the format: 'En [day of the week], yo...'. (For example: 'En lunes, yo leo un libro.')
