

Rosa's Weekly Diary: Mi Diario de la Semana

Learning objective: To be able to write the days of the week in Spanish and describe a simple activity for each day.

Rosa the parrot is learning to keep a diary in Spanish! Use this template to record what you do each day. Write the Spanish word for the day of the week, then write a short sentence in English about what you are doing on that day. Use the word bank to help you with your spelling.

Word bank: lunes (Monday) · martes (Tuesday) · miércoles (Wednesday) · jueves (Thursday) · viernes (Friday) · sábado (Saturday) · domingo (Sunday)

1. Lunes: Write the Spanish day and one thing you do at school on Mondays. (2 marks)

2. Martes: Write the Spanish day and one hobby you enjoy on Tuesdays. (2 marks)

3. Miércoles: Write the Spanish day and one thing you are looking forward to this Wednesday. (2 marks)

4. Jueves: Write the Spanish day and something you might eat or drink this Thursday. (2 marks)

5. Viernes: Write the Spanish day and your favourite way to relax on a Friday evening. (2 marks)

6. Sábado y Domingo: Write the Spanish days and describe your favourite weekend activity. (4 marks)

Extension challenge: Choose two days of the week and write a full sentence in Spanish, such as 'El lunes voy a la escuela' (On Monday I go to school).
