2. 2. 'La mujer que me dio la vida es mi _____. ' (1 mark)

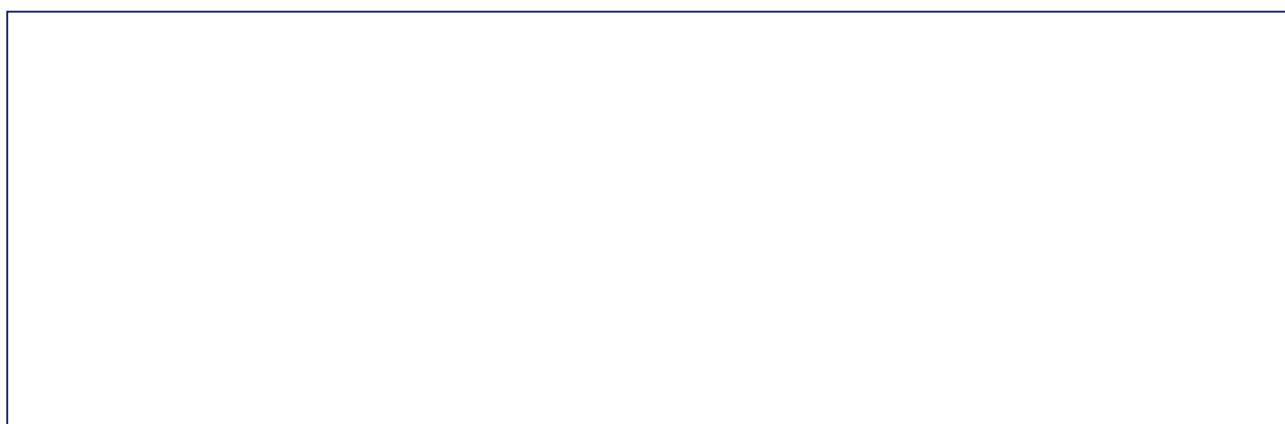
3. 3. 'Mi hermano de mi madre es mi _____. ' (1 mark)
