

Mi Familia - My Family Tree Drawing Sheet

Learning objective: To identify and use Spanish vocabulary for family members and present them in a creative format.

Follow the drawing prompt to create your own family tree. Use the word bank to label each character in your drawing correctly in Spanish.

Draw: Draw a large, friendly oak tree in the centre of your page. On the branches, draw small circular portraits of your family members. Use a clear, colourful style. Include yourself ('yo') near the bottom of the tree. Ensure there is enough space around each portrait to write the Spanish labels clearly.



Label words: la madre · el padre · la hermana · el hermano · la abuela · el abuelo · el bebé · yo

Steps:

1. Draw your family members on the tree branches. Label each person using the correct Spanish word from the word bank.
2. Write a sentence in Spanish to introduce one of your family members (e.g., 'Esta es mi madre').
3. What is the difference between 'el' and 'la' when talking about family members?
4. If you wanted to say 'my brother', which word from the bank would you use?
5. Add a small speech bubble to your drawing. Write 'Hola' and the name of one family member in Spanish.
