

Mi Familia: Meeting the Family

Join Rosa the parrot on a journey to learn how to introduce your loved ones in Spanish!

- To introduce your mother, you say: 'Esta es mi madre'.
- To introduce your father, you say: 'Este es mi padre'.
- If you have a brother, he is 'mi hermano'. If you have a sister, she is 'mi hermana'.
- When asking for a name, use: '¿Cómo se llama tu madre?'
- To say 'my grandmother', use the feminine article: 'mi abuela'.
- To describe your family, you can say 'Mi familia es grande' (My family is big) or 'pequeña' (small).

Did you know? Did you know? In Spanish-speaking countries, it is very common to have two surnames! Usually, the first surname comes from the father and the second surname comes from the mother. This helps families keep track of their history through both sides of the family tree.
