

Rosa's Family Fact-File: Mi Familia

Learning objective: To use Spanish vocabulary to describe family members and their characteristics, in line with Year 5 language objectives.

Hello! I am Rosa, your bilingual parrot friend. Today, we are going to build a 'Mi Familia' fact-file. Use your knowledge of Spanish family nouns and adjectives to complete each section below. Make sure to use the word bank to help you spell your Spanish vocabulary correctly!

Word bank: madre (mother) · padre (father) · hermano/a (brother/sister) · abuelo/a (grandfather/grandmother) · amable (kind) · gracioso/a (funny) · inteligente (intelligent) · alto/a (tall) · bajo/a (short)

1. Los miembros de mi familia: List three members of your family in Spanish and describe their relationship to you. (3 marks)

2. Descripciones físicas: Choose two family members and write one sentence in Spanish for each, describing their height or appearance. (4 marks)

3. Personalidad: Write a sentence in Spanish explaining one personality trait for a family member (e.g., 'Mi madre es amable'). (2 marks)

4. La comparación: Can you write a sentence comparing two family members? For example, who is taller? Use the phrase 'más... que' (more... than). (3 marks)

5. Opinión personal: Write a short sentence in Spanish about why you love your family. (2 marks)

Extension challenge: Challenge yourself: Write a short paragraph of 3-4 sentences in Spanish describing a family pet or a cousin, including their name, age, and one interesting fact about them.
