

Rosa's Spanish Food Feast

Learning objective: To learn and recall vocabulary for common food items in Spanish and use them in simple sentences.

Rosa the parrot is hosting a picnic! Read the front of the flashcard to see the Spanish word, then flip it over to check the English translation and a helpful tip from Rosa.

la manzana

Apple. Rosa says: 'Recuerda: An apple a day keeps the doctor away!'

el plátano

Banana. Rosa says: 'These are perfect for a quick energy boost during our adventures.'

el pan

Bread. Rosa says: 'A staple food in many cultures around the world.'

el queso

Cheese. Rosa says: 'This contains calcium, which is great for strong bones.'

la leche

Milk. Rosa says: 'In Spanish, we use 'la' for feminine nouns and 'el' for masculine.'

el agua

Water. Rosa says: 'Crucial for staying hydrated while exploring!'

el pollo

Chicken. Rosa says: 'A very common source of protein in Spanish-speaking countries.'

la ensalada

Salad. Rosa says: 'Think of all the colourful vegetables you can include.'

el arroz

Rice. Rosa says: 'A versatile grain used in dishes like paella.'

el chocolate

Chocolate. Rosa says: 'A sweet treat to enjoy in moderation!'
